Dear Parents/Carers,

I currently have a small number of spaces to teach the violin and viola starting after May half term, and I am more than happy for any child to have a trial lesson before committing to weekly lessons.

Children can start learning the violin from Year 1, and the viola from Year 3 due to the sizes of the instruments.

The tuition is provided as a 15-minute individual lesson, and this means that a productive amount of time can be spent with your child on a 1:1 basis. All instruments are loaned to students free of charge.

Tuition fees are paid in advance direct to NMPAT, not the school. If, after your child starts their lessons, you wish to discontinue those lessons, you should give a minimum of five teaching weeks' notice to NMPAT.

What to do next:

If you would like your child to start instrumental lessons in school with me after half term, please email NMPAT using this email address: lessonsdirect@NMPAT.co.uk and state your child's name and school, and which instrument they would like to learn. NMPAT will then register your interest and contact you with regard to availability and cost. **Please do this by Friday, May 22nd.**
