



Welcome to our 100 club – launching in 2024!

A great way for you to support us whilst having a bit of a flutter! Here's how it works...

When we launch, you'll need to complete a membership form and transfer £20 to the FOHS bank account if you want to take part.

We'll allocate you a membership number, which enters you into the termly draw. The membership is valid for one school year.

The draw will take place on the last day of every term. Note that in 2024 we will carry out 2 draws at the end of the summer term as a result of starting the 100 Club mid-year.

If you win, a cheque will be made available for collection from school. Winners will be notified in the school newsletter.

The prize money will be 50% of the membership fees sold. The remaining 50% goes to the school to help fund equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils. The 50% prize pot will be split across the 3 draws during the year. Therefore, if all 100 memberships are sold, a prize pot of £1000 will be available, with £333 allocated for each draw. Of this, 1st prize will receive 50%, 2nd prize 35% and 3rd prize 15%.

All memberships must be purchased prior to the first draw.

100 club rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the FOHS bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

1. For a cost of £20 per school year you will be allocated one number between one and 100.
2. A draw will be made on the last day of every term (2 draws will be made in the summer term of 2024).
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. The prize pot will be apportioned as follows: 1st prize will receive 50%, 2nd prize 35% and 3rd prize 15%.
5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Helmdon Primary School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to two per household.
7. Payments must be made by bank transfer.
8. Memberships must be purchased before the first draw, initially Easter 2024 and Christmas for each year after.
9. A membership is valid for one school year only.
10. The draw shall be made by the headteacher or a member of the FOHS committee in the last assembly of each full term.
11. The winning cheque will be made available from the school office.
12. The names of each term's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and individuals will be emailed to inform them.
13. The 100 Club will be run by FOHS. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her membership renewal is not paid by the end of the autumn/winter term.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into FOHS funds after six months.
